

EARTHWORMS INDICATE HEALTHY SOILS

Intensive agricultural soil practices put soil under pressure



This contributes to bad soil structure and increased risk for soil erosion

These pressures can decrease earthworm numbers



Alternative agricultural practices as reduced tillage, organic agriculture, and crop rotation can favour earthworms and maintain soil functions
