

# Estonia - land use



50% of Estonian territory is covered by forest

20% is arable land



Less of the area is covered by natural grasslands, swamps and infrastructure.

From agricultural area 39% is utilized for forage crops



50% is used for cereals

13% is occupied by oilseed and technical crops



10% by pulses and smaller part is under potatoes and vegetables.

In Estonia can be found intensively managed, mixed type farms, composed by dairy farming and crop production but also alternative and organic farms, located on West-Coast of Estonia and on Islands, which consequently affects the soil quality.
